WELCOME BABY: PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

Welcome Baby strives to strengthen families with young children ages 0-5 by providing accurate child development information and emotional and practical support to Durham County families. Current research confirms that a supportive family life is the greatest factor for a child's success in school.

Parenting Workshops

- The Incredible Years – a class that provides information and strategies to gain children's cooperation, to reduce the use of time out and to use praise and encouragement effectively.
- Motherread/Fatherread – classes that teach the most effective way to read to your children.
- Positive Parenting Program (Triple P) – offered in discussion group and one-on-one consultation format. Triple P gives parents skills to address behavior issues with their children.
- All parenting workshops are offered in both Spanish and English.
- All parenting workshops are free and have dinner, childcare and transportation provided if needed.

Car Seat Safety Program

- Participants learn how to safely install and use car seats as well as review current laws and best practices.
- Upon completion, families may purchase a car seat on a sliding fee scale.

Giving Closet

- Families can receive clothing and accessories six times per year for their children ages newborn to 5 years.
- Maternity items and breastfeeding accessories are also available.
- The Giving Closet happens every Friday from 8:30 a.m. – 11:10 a.m. and 1 p.m. – 3:10 p.m. and every second Thursday of the month from 4 p.m. – 6:10 p.m. at 721 Foster St. in Durham.

Cribs for Kids®

- As a national Cribs for Kids® chapter, Welcome Baby purchases and distributes new Pack 'n Play portable cribs for parents in need.
- Each family receives Cribs for Kids® safe sleep training before receiving a crib.
